An Examination of Wage Changes in U.S. Micropolitan Statistical Areas

Where have wages grown the most?




As we prepare to celebrate Labor Day, Garner Economics examined wage changes in <u>Micropolitan</u> statistical areas over the past five years.

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Metropolitan and Micropolitan statistical areas are defined by the Office of Management and Budget as geographic entities used for statistical purposes based on counties and county-equivalents. Micropolitan areas are urban areas in the United States centered on an urban cluster with a population of 10,000 to 49,999¹. As of February 2013, there were **381 metropolitan statistical areas** and **536 micropolitan statistical** areas in the United States.

Micropolitan cities are significant centers of population and production, with 8.4% of the U.S. population residing in them. Examination of average weekly wage change in these micro areas across the past five years (2009-2014) provides insight into the varied economic dynamics of these areas.²



¹ A metro area contains a core urban area of 50,000 or more population, and a micro area contains an urban core of at least 10,000 (but less than 50,000) population. Each metro or micro area consists of one or more counties and includes the counties containing the core urban area, as well as any adjacent counties that have a high degree of social and economic integration (as measured by commuting to work) with the urban core. Because the designation is based on the core urban cluster's population and not on that of the whole area, some Micropolitan areas are actually larger than some metropolitan areas.

² Due to 2013 changes in micropolitan area classficiation, wage change is only reported for the 487 micropolitan areas in the U.S. definied in both 2010 and 2014.

As the map indicates, wages in most micropolitan areas have grown over the past five years. Nationally, the average weekly wage rose by \$112, increasing from \$876 to \$988 in 2014. Workers in 14% of the micros saw their weekly wages increase at or above the U.S. average weekly wage change.

Micropolitan areas located in the oil rich states of North Dakota, Texas, and Oklahoma top the overall list of largest weekly wage changes. Williston, North Dakota, ranked first, experienced an increase of \$689, rising from \$904 in 2009 to \$1,593 in 2014. Williston's economy, primarily driven by the oil industry, has seen a huge increase in population and infrastructure investments during the last several years with expanded drilling. Population has also boomed, rising from 22,573 in 2010 to 32,130 in 2014.

Seven micropolitan areas, conversely, experienced a decrease in average wage. Below are the micropolitan areas with the smallest change in weekly wage. Enterprise, AL and Wilmington, OH experienced the largest wage losses, with Enterprise decreasing by \$110 from \$723 to \$613 and Wilmington, OH dropping \$162 from \$924 to \$762.
